12 years of documentaries for children and youth: This year's festival programme

Do I have to fit in?

Many protagonists of this year's *doxs!* festival programme are asking themselves this particular question. They are thoughtful, impulsive straight shooters with their own minds and heads. They dream and think freely, regardless of the trouble that life has in store for them - even some problems that one is not supposed to be dealing with at this young age.

doxs! kino shows **28 contemporary documentaries** from Europe and Asia. Nine of them will be on German screens for the first time. One will be celebrating its world premier. The movies represent the variety of topics that have vast impact on today's children and youth: pressure of performance, beauty dictates, exclusion and bullying, life with a handicap and multi-cultural biographies. The selected productions are taking their audience seriously and confront it with unfamiliar settings, foreign cultures but also with problems that shape the reception of the world they experience every day. The programme allows the audience to explore the variety of issues and aesthetics documentary filmmaking has to offer.

For the first time *doxs! kino* presents three productions from Indonesia. They represent the outcome of **KID DOK**, a *doxs!* project that, for one year, supported filmmakers from Jakarta, Indonesia, in developing and realizing documentary shorts for children.

Another delightful novelty is the introduction of **two further screening locations**: Due to high regional demand, full capacity of the filmforum in Duisburg was reached. Therefore *doxs!* is happy to announce additional screenings in collaboration with *endstation.kino* in Bochum and *Kino im U, Dortmunder U – Zentrum für Kunst und Kreativität* in Dortmund.

For the third time *doxs!* in collaboration with the **Federal Agency for Civic Education** awards one of nine nominated documentaries with the **European film price GROSSE KLAPPE**. A youth jury will choose the winner of the price, which is endowed with 3,500 Euros. Members of this jury will present the award to the winner at the festival on November 8th.
